The university's infirmary provides services in three stages: prevention, diagnosis, and treatment-monitoring. In the prevention stage, the aim is to assess students' health levels, identify harmful habits, detect students with chronic illnesses, recognize diseases early, and prepare for emergency communication. In line with this goal, student health surveys are conducted within the university to provide information about their health status. The infirmary also aims to raise awareness, offer solutions, and assist students in coping with personal, emotional, social, familial, professional, and other issues through individual or group consultations. In cases requiring further attention, relevant students are guided and referred to appropriate services as needed. The infirmary is located between Blocks D and B.

**What is UBIS? How is it used? What information can I access through UBIS?**

UBIS is a Student Automation System that you, as students, can access throughout your academic life from anywhere with internet access and on all mobile devices. Through UBIS, you can view your course and exam schedules, access lecture notes uploaded by your instructors, check your attendance status, and access your financial information. You can also fill out your in-place practice and internship forms. Additionally, UBIS allows you to access your transcript information, courses offered by your department, and course content.

Attendance Requirement for Classes: 70%**How do Kiosks and the Smart Classroom Application help? How can I use them?**

By using your student ID cards at the kiosks, you can quickly access your class schedule, exam schedule, and exam results. In the smart classroom applications, you can record your attendance for a class by scanning your ID card on the information screens or track which instructor is teaching which subject at that time. You can also view the course plan for the classroom via the information screens.

Istanbul Aydın University, by being the first in Turkey, offers its students one day per week of on-site practice training. Through this training, our students have the opportunity to apply what they have learned, get introduced to the business world, and increase their work-life experience. This training is mandatory for three semesters: in the 2nd, 3rd, and 4th semesters for Vocational Schools, and in the 5th, 6th, and 7th semesters for Faculties.

What is the purpose?

The purpose of On-Site Practice is to place our students in suitable departments at the physical locations of our solution partners on certain days of the week. Initially, they are expected to observe, familiarize themselves with the organization's system, witness work relationships and communications, and gradually become involved in the workflow and processes. Over time, they are encouraged to contribute and participate actively, with the aim of turning this experience into mutual benefit and efficiency.

How long will it last?

The academic term at Istanbul Aydın University is 15 weeks long. After the start of the term, one week is allocated for selection, placement, and planning. On-site practice lasts for 14 weeks on the designated days.

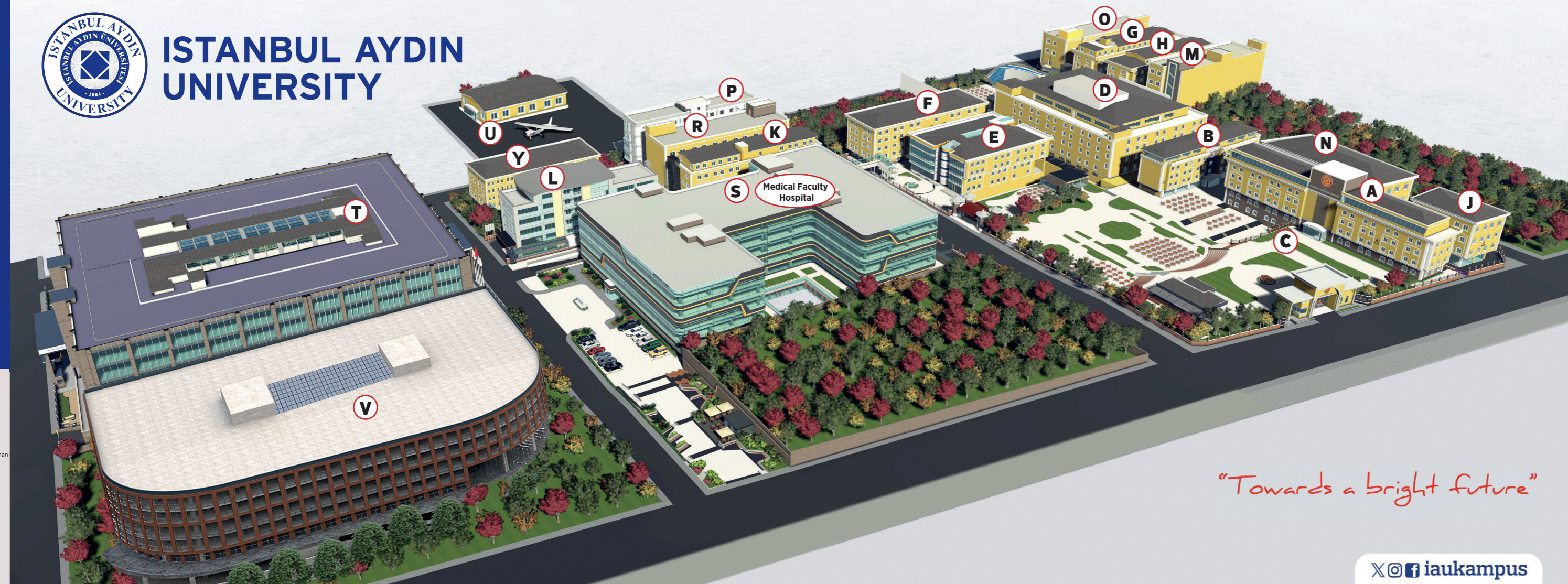

The Library and Documentation Center of Istanbul Aydın University aims to meet information needs at the highest level in the shortest time by supporting modern library services with the latest technological developments. For this purpose, the collection includes both local and international publications covering specialized subjects relevant to department programs, as well as periodicals, reference sources, and professional publications. Additionally, internet-connected computers are available to support academic research.

In our library, resources are organized according to the "Dewey Decimal Classification System" and operate on an open-shelf system. The Dewey Decimal Classification System categorizes resources based on their subjects, making it possible to directly access books and journals in the library.

What days and hours is the IAU Library open?

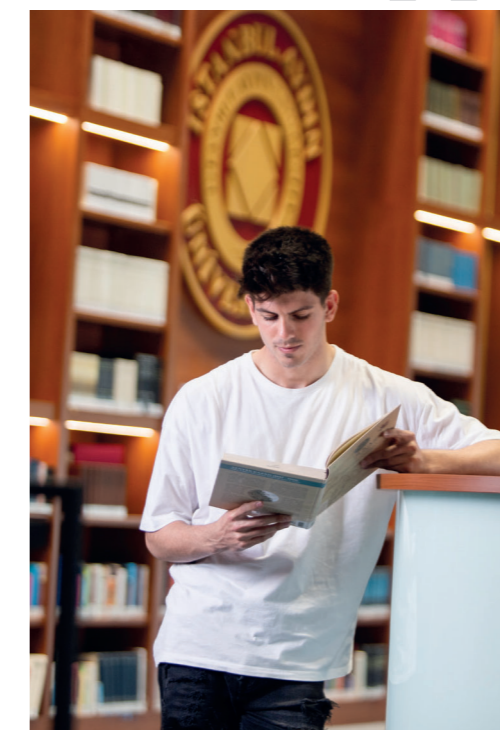
Our libraries are open 24/7 and serve in Blocks P and T of the Florya campus.
